

The Zambia Qualifications Framework

- In 2015 implemented a 10-level National Qualifications
 Framework. The Zambia Qualifications Framework (ZQF)
 and its Level descriptors were developed in collaboration
 with stakeholders and Gazetted to the general public.
- The ZQF is used for classification, registration, articulation and recognition of all local and foreign qualifications in Zambia
- The ZQF harmonises and integrates all qualifications in the Zambian Education system thereby promoting access, mobility diverse learning pathways and progression for learners.
- The framework is one of the crucial standards for the quality of existing and new qualifications in the country
- All qualifications in Zambia must be registered on the NQF and ZAQA Publishes an annual list of registered qualifications that meet the set requirements

Quality Assurance in Trades and Vocational Training

ZAQA conducts quality assurance through monitoring of TEVETA, registration of qualifications



Technical Education Vocational and Entrepreneurship Training Authority (TEVETA)

- Develops and **approves curricula** that meet standards prescribed on the ZQF
- TEVETA **conducts assessments** and awards qualifications that meet relevant ZQF Standards
- The Authority **conducts External Quality Assurance** on public and private Technical and Vocational Institutions to ensure compliance to TEVT training standards and ZQF level descriptors
- TEVETA is mandated to ensure that qualifications under its ambit are registered on the ZQF
- The institution is also mandated to ensure adherence to the appropriate ZQF-level descriptors



Quality Assurance in Higher Education Institutions

ZAQA conducts quality assurance through monitoring of HEA and registration of qualifications recommended by HEA



- HEA is mandated to register Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) and accredit learning programmes of HEIs in accordance with appropriate ZQF level descriptors.
- The Authority conducts External Quality Assurance on public and private HEIs to ensure adherence with ZQF and other higher educational standards.
- HEA registers learning programmes and recommends qualifications of HEIs that have meet all quality assurance requirements to be registered on the ZQF.
- HEA has developed a **categorisation for HEIs** based on the ZQF-levels. This categorisation demonstrates the quality and level of education an HEI can offer.

Conclusions on Quality Assurance and the ZQF

• The **ZQF** is a curial standard of Quality **Assurance** in the Zambian education system.

 All Appropriate Authorities mandated to conduct Quality Assurance (QA) have developed mechanisms and frameworks that comply to the ZQF and its level descriptors.

 All Qualifications issued in Zambia are required to be registered on the ZQF and registration on the ZQF demonstrates that a qualification has met all quality assurance standards. The Zambia Qualifications Framework covering three sub-frameworks managed by Appropriate Authorities
