# **SADC** QF Brainstorming

#### What is it?

- Regional mechanism comparability and recognition of full <u>qualifications</u>, <u>credit transfer</u>, <u>creation of regional standards</u>, <u>quality assurance</u>.
- Agreed principles, practices, procedures, and standardized terminology intended to meet the purposes of the SADCQF.

#### Why

- Enhancing mobility of skills, + those of researchers students across the Region.
- Very important milestone by establishing the SADC QF with the accompanying quality assurance guidelines

#### Level

- 10-level QF underpinned by learning outcomes and quality assurance mechanisms
- Approved & launched by Mo Education & Training, Science, Technology & Innovation

### Add Value


- Comprehensive RQF for Schooling, Technical & Vocational Education & Training (TVET) & Higher Education.
- All new qualifications -- certificates, diplomas & other documents issued by competent authorities -- will contain the relevant descriptors on the SADC QF.

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### Principles

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- Regional solidarity, co-operation; interaction with global & local FQ reference;
- strengthening of national education & training systems;
- Quality enhancement and strengthening of education and training in the region;
- Respect for regional and multilateral decisions; Equity within & among MS; responsiveness and relevance.





# SADCQF-ACQF : Cooperation Region-continent

#### Harmonization of Qualifications :

**Ob:** To establish common standards for **Q** across African countries to facilitate the mutual recognition of skills and diplomas.

Benf: Ensures the comparability of qualifications, reducing barriers to academic professional mobility. Enh. Mobility :

**Ob** : To make it easier for students and professionals to move between MS to study or work.

**Benf:** Increases training - employment opport. & helps to meet the needs of the labour market on a regional and continental scale.

### Quality of Education and Training

**Ob:** To raise the standards of education & vocational training in Africa.

**Benf:** Ensures that qualifications obtained in # countries meet high quality standards, thereby strengthening the confidence of employers & educational institutions.

### Institutional Capacity Building :


**Ob:** To help MS develop strong institutional capacity to manage & administer their **QFs**. **Benefits:** Ensures effective & sustainable implementation of national and regional Q systems. <u>Sharing Good Practice :</u>

**Ob:** Facilitate exchange of knowledge & experience between MS

Benf: Enables proven solutions to be adopted & NQFs to be improved through mutual learning.

### SADCQF-ACQF : Cooperation Country-Region-Continent Context, foundation and cooperation phase





#### **Pan-African initiatives :**

**2006**: Launch of the QF for African Higher Education under the auspices of the AU, laying the foundations for the development of regional and continental QF.

**2007:** Creation of the PA for the Second Decade of Education in Africa, which emphasizes the importance of harmonizing qualifications across the continent.

#### **Development of the SADC QF:**

2011: SADC adopts the SADC QF) to harmonise qualifications and improve the quality of education in the Southern African region.

#### **Creation of the ACQF:**

2019 : The AU, with the support of partners such as the EU, officially launches the process of developing ACQF).



# SADCQF-ACQF : Cooperation Region-continent

### Perspectives

- Continues to evolve with clear objectives to strengthen the harmonisation of qualifications, improve the quality of education
- Facilitate the mutual recognition of competences.
- Include extending this cooperation to other regions and QF in Africa,
- Strengthening initiatives to digitize & monitor qualifications to meet the challenges of the 21st century.



# SADCQF-ACQF : Cooperation Region-continent

### **Initiatives & Activities**



Workshops and Seminars: Organization of regular meetings to discuss the challenges and opportunities linked to the harmonization of qualifications.

**Pilot Projects:** Launching pilot projects to test and refine approaches to qualifications harmonisation before full-scale implementation.

Assessments and Audits: Carrying out assessments of existing qualifications systems to identify areas for improvement.





### SADCQF-ACQF : Cooperation Country-Continent Results and impact



- **1. Standardization and Quality** : Improved quality of education & training through harmonized standards & common quality criteria.
- **2**. **Mobility and Employability** : Increased mobility of students & skilled workers across the African continent, improving their employability & meeting the needs of the regional continental labour market.
- **3. Regional & Continental Integration** : Strengthening regional & continental integration through coherent & harmonized education policies.
- **4. Partnerships & Collaboration :** Establishment of strong partnerships between educational institutions & governments of SADC MS & other African regions.



# SADCQF-ACQF : Cooperation Country-Continent

#### Long term impact



**Economic development:** A skilled and mobile workforce can stimulate economic development by better meeting the needs of the labour market

**Regional Integration:** Cooperation strengthens regional and continental integration, unifying member countries' efforts to achieve common goals in educational development

**Social inclusion:** By facilitating access to quality education and improving employability, cooperation helps to reduce inequalities and promote social inclusion

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

# Roadmap 2023-2026

**Follow-up to alignment**: Use of SADCQF levels on newly issued qualifications documents of NQF aligned/referenced to the SADCQF: develop the concept and guideline, submit it to approval by the ministers.

Streamlining and reactivating alignment/referencing to SADCQF: support & invite all SACD MS to plan & participate in the process.

SADCQF Guidelines and Manuals on RPL, CAT, Recognition dissemination, training, support to application transposition at country level.. New developments related to digitalization of qualifications management, microcredentials, common profiles (occupations, qualifications, and new skills)

Capacity development and peer sharing: national level, SADC level, and wider international level

> Strengthening of cooperation with the ACQF and EQF

> > **M&E** systems & instruments to support a plan-domonitor-review approach for SADQF implementation.

> > > On improved governance, organization, resources of the implementation of SADCQF
