ABOUT THE ZAMBIA QUALIFICATIONS AUTHORITY

Statutory Body under the Ministry of Education in Zambia

Established through an Act of Parliament, ZAQA Act No. 13 of 2011

ZQF

Custodian of ALL Qualifications in Zambia through Registration and Accreditation

Reference point for ALL Non-Zambian qualifications for Validation and Evaluation





ABOUT THE ZAMBIA QUALIFICATIONS FRAMEWORK

2015 - Developed the ZQF and level descriptors in consultation with stakeholders

Ten level qualifications framework

ZQF

Divided in three subframeworks namely: General and Further Education, Trades and Occupations and Higher Education

Commenced the registration and accreditation of qualifications on the ZQF in 2017 (523 registered to date)

All existing Level Descriptors have been comprehensively reviewed and updated


Level Descriptors have been introduced for all new qualifications
