

About the training Program

The training program of the project ACQF-II in 2023 contributes to enhance knowledge and understanding on the development and operationalization of NQFs: moving from initial ideas to policies, and from policies to action.

The number of countries in Africa with NQFs at stage of development and consultation, and at stage of implementation has been growing in the last years – approx. 33 countries can be included in this group. On the other side, many countries are at initial stage of reflection regarding their future NQF. Among countries with longstanding NQF implementation experience, the majority are reviewing and improving important aspects and instruments of the NQF, enabling their responsiveness to changing needs and learning. NQFs are not set in stone, they adapt.

NQFs are evolving, widening their scope, and engaging with digitalization. Learning in all contexts (including non-formal and informal) matters more than ever, as the transformation of work, technologies and greening of the economy requires faster re- and up-skilling, flexible acquisition of credentials for lifelong learning and work, and transparent qualifications based on quality and trusted provision at all levels of the NQF. Responsive and effective NQFs contribute to the SDG-4 and 8, and to the wider objectives of skills revolution, social inclusion, and improved employability for all categories of the population.

The project ACQF-II (2023-end 2026) is structured to deliver on three key outcomes:

1. Output 1: Capacity development, networking, and mutual learning.
2. Output 2: Support to countries and regions: NQF development and implementation.
3. Output 3: Governance and implementation capacity: Governance set-up. ACQF Qualifications and Credentials Platform. Referencing NQF-ACQF. Common profiles of qualifications.

In 2023 the project ACQF-II organises two training workshops (Nairobi and Accra) and the annual conference (Maputo). These events will be multilingual and streamed. The relevant national NQF authorities are committed and motivated to co-host these events.

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About the training Program



Participants include institutions responsible for the coordination and management of NQFs, Regional Economic Communities (IGAD and SADC), organisations responsible for quality assurance in education and training (CAMES, IUCEA, GQAA), All-Africa Students Union, UNESCO, and experts. Countries represented: Angola, Ghana, Guinea-Bissau, Djibouti, Eswatini, Mozambique, Democratic Republic of Congo, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, and South Sudan. Also participating are the two co-chairs of the ACQF Advisory Group (Cameroon and SADC) and countries with globally recognised NQF experience (South Africa – SAQA) and Kenya (KNQA).

The three events share a **common thematic agenda**, based on the following main themes:

- 1.NQF in a changing world: Development, implementation, monitoring and review / adaptation.
NQF instruments and processes, quality assurance.
- 2.Registration of qualifications in NQF / register – benchmarking.
- 3.Qualifications are changing. Adaptation to green and digital transformation, digitalization, new types of credentials.
- 4.Validation and recognition of learning outcomes and skills / competences from different contexts of learning. Skills and competences of labour migrants and refugees.
- 5.Micro-credentials: new opportunities for flexible pathways, lifelong learning, employability, and career development. A global movement.
- 6.Shaping comparability of qualifications and credentials to facilitate portability, recognition of qualifications, and mutual trust.
- 7.Governance of skills and qualifications ecosystems: governance models, linked policies, information and analysis, stakeholders' participation, and comparisons between NQFs-RQFs and ACQF. Complementarities between Addis Recognition Convention, ACQF, NQFs.

Le programme de formation du projet ACQF-II en 2023 contribue à améliorer les connaissances et la compréhension sur le développement et l'opérationnalisation des CNC : passer des idées initiales aux politiques, et des politiques à l'action.

Le nombre de pays africains dotés de CNC au stade de développement et de consultation, et au stade de la mise en œuvre, a augmenté ces dernières années – environ 33 pays peuvent être inclus dans ce groupe. D'autre part, les autres pays sont au stade initial de la réflexion concernant leur futur CNC. Parmi les pays ayant une longue expérience de la mise en œuvre du CNC, la majorité est engagée dans l'examen et perfectionnement des aspects et des instruments importants du CNC, ce qui leur permet de réagir à l'évolution des besoins et d'apprendre. Les CNC ne sont pas figés, ils s'adaptent.

Les CNC évoluent, élargissent leur champ d'application et s'engagent dans la numérisation. L'apprentissage dans tous les contextes (y compris non formel et informel) est plus important que jamais, car la transformation du travail, des technologies et l'écologisation de l'économie exigent une requalification et une mise à niveau plus rapides, une acquisition flexible de titres de compétences pour l'apprentissage et le travail tout au long de la vie, ainsi que des certifications transparentes fondées sur une offre fiable et de qualité à tous les niveaux du CNC. Des CNC réactifs et efficaces contribuent aux ODD-4 et 8 et aux objectifs plus larges de révolution des compétences, d'inclusion sociale et d'amélioration de l'employabilité de toutes les catégories de la population.

Sobre o workshop de formao

O programa de formação do projeto ACQF-II em 2023 contribui para reforçar o conhecimento e a compreensão sobre o desenvolvimento e operacionalização dos QNQ: passar das ideias iniciais para as políticas e das políticas para a ação.

O número de países africanos com QNQ em fase de desenvolvimento e consulta e em fase de implementação tem vindo a aumentar nos últimos anos – cerca de 33 países podem ser incluídos neste grupo. Por outro lado, muitos países encontram-se numa fase inicial de reflexão sobre o seu futuro QNQ. Entre os países com uma longa experiência de implementação do QNQ, a maioria está a rever e a melhorar aspectos e instrumentos importantes do QNQ, permitindo a sua capacidade de resposta à evolução das necessidades e da aprendizagem. Os QNQ não podem ser rígidos, devem adaptar-se.

Os QNQ estão a evoluir, a alargar o seu âmbito e a conciliar-se com a digitalização. A aprendizagem em todos os contextos (incluindo não formal e informal) é mais importante do que nunca, uma vez que a transformação do trabalho, as tecnologias e a ecologização da economia exigem a melhoria rápida e constante das aptidões e competências, uma aquisição flexível de credenciais para a aprendizagem ao longo da vida e o trabalho e qualificações transparentes baseadas na qualidade e numa oferta fiável a todos os níveis do QNQ. QNQ reativos e eficazes contribuem para os ODS-4 e 8 e para os objetivos mais amplos de revolução das competências, inclusão social e melhoria da empregabilidade para todas as categorias da população.

O projeto ACQF-II (de 2023-final de 2026) está estruturado para produzir três resultados principais:

- 1.Resultado 1: Desenvolvimento de capacidades, reforço da cooperação em rede e aprendizagem mútua.
 - 2.Resultado 2: Apoio aos países e regiões: desenvolvimento e implementação do QNQ.
 - 3.Resultado 3: Governação e capacidade de execução: estrutura de governação. Plataforma de Qualificações e Credenciais ACQF. Referenciação NQF-ACQF. Perfis comuns de qualificações
- Em 2023, o projeto ACQF-II organiza dois workshops de formação (Nairobi e Acra) e a conferência anual (Maputo). Estes eventos serão multilingues e transmitidos em streaming. As autoridades nacionais competentes do QNQ estão empenhadas e motivadas a coorganizar estes eventos.
