- Law n°. 23/2014 reviewed and republished by Law n°.
 6/2016 Professional Education Law
- Decree 58/2021 august 17 approving the System de Recognition of Acquired Skills (SRCA) (=RPL)
- Order de 03 de November de 2021, of the Secretary of State for Vocational Technical Education, which approves the SRCA Regulation.



2. THE GOVERNANCE OF THE RCA SYSTEM

Law n°. 23/2014 reviewed and republished by Law n°. 6/2016 establishes the National Professional Education Authority (ANEP), Regulatory and Quality Assurance body of Professional Education in Mozambique

The governance of the SRCA is guaranteed by the ANEP

4.1 CHARACTERIZATION AND GENERAL PURPOSE OF SRCA (RPL)

Characterization (definition) of SRCA:

Mechanism through which extra-institutional professional training is integrated / included in the Sub-system of Professional Education

Objectivo Geral do SRCA:

Valorizar, avaliar, reconhecer e certificar competências obtidas pelos cidadãos ao longo da vida, em percursos formais, não-formais ou informais.

4.3. RCA CANDIDATES

The SRCA is applicable to individuals:

- 18 years of age and older and
- with proven experience of at least 3 years in an area related to the qualification to which they apply



4.9 THE CERTIFICATION OF SKILLS



Full Certification

Partial Certification (only a few competence units of the qualification)

Principle:

Award, through the RCA (RPL) process, of certificates equal to those obtained through the formal training process.

Certifying Entity: ANEP

Process Management Instrument: **SEGI** (Electronic Information

Management System)

5. ACTIONS CARRIED OUT

- Continuous development of the CNQP: 164 Qualifications currently
- Implementation of a pilot project for the implementation of SRCA, in partnership with SWISSCONTACT:

Preparation of 5 RCA Standards:

- Plumber assembler and repairman
- Oxyacetylenic Welding
- Welding with Coated Electrodes
- Electricity Built-in Installations
- Mason

Accredited 3 RCA Centers

Training of RCA Facilitators/Evaluators

- Formed 14 trainers
- Certificates 8 of these trainers

Candidates:

- Registered: 44
- Admitted to Practical Assessment: 36
- Certifiied: 25
 - 11 in Plumbing
 - 7 in Oxyacetylenic Welding
 - 7 in Electricity

6. ACTIONS TO BE CARRIED OUT IN 2022

- Publicize / disseminate the SRCA
 - Edit and distribute the brochure "Methodological Guidelines for the Implementation of SRCA"
 - Make available on the ANEP webpage:
 - RCA Standards
 - the reference documents of this system
 - information/data on the implementation of the SRCA
- Register in CNQP the RCA Facilitator/Evaluator Certificate
- Elaborate RCA Standards in the areas of Agriculture, Civil Construction, Industrial maintenance and Hospitality and Tourism
- Train at least 25 RCA Facilitators/Evaluators
- Consolidate the training previously given to Facilitators/Evaluators
- Believe at least 5 RCA Centers
- Ensure the registration in the SEGI of the implementation data of the SRCA



7. CHALLENGES

Expansion and Consolidation of the SRCA / RPL

Mapping, at national level:

- existing regulation on the requirement of certification for the exercise of occupations
- RCA needs

Increase and diversification of RCA Standards in CNQP

Continuous training of ANEP staff, in topics such as: elaboration of RCA References, definition and evaluation of blocks of competences, among others.

Extension of the network of RCA Centres

Adequacy of the SEGI to the SRCA, including the introduction of an interaction functionality with candidates and stakeholders in general
