In 2010, the Government conducted a comprehensive analysis of the education and training system which informed establishment of :

The Eswatini Higher Education Council (ESHEC)

► The Eswatini Qualifications Authorities, among other entities

## The Establishment of the EQA


- In 2022, responsibilities on quality assurance and qualifications were streamlined.
- EQA started operations in August 2022 Cabinet decision
- The mandate of EQA is the development, implementation and maintenance of the national qualifications Framework
- The functions include, among other things:
  - Policy & Guidelines on design and implementation
  - Verification and evaluation of qualifications
  - Registration of qualifications obtained from all levels

# The Eswatini Qualifications Framework (ESQF)

ESQF is in stage 4, legally approved and implementation has started.

- Has ten levels, seven situated at under graduate level and three at post graduate level
- An integrated framework encompassing the whole education sector, ensuring comparability and transparency of qualifications in the different field of learning
- Three domains; knowledge, skills and personal attributes
- Embraces learning outcomes and encourages backward approach model for programme design

- Cabinet approval (2020)
- Participated in alignment of SADCQF to NQFs pilot project/ National Alignment Committee established.
- Development and launch of the Credit Accumulation and Transfer System Policy and Guidelines
- Development and Launch of Qualification Registration Guidelines
- Classification of study fields and subfields established based on UNESCO ISCED
- RPL Policy and Guidelines under development
- EQA website active
- Verification of qualifications

### Current initiatives

- Finalisation of the RPL Process and approval
- Fully digitalising our processes
  - Development of online searchable database of qualifications
  - Development of National Learner Records Database
  - Automation of the verifications process
  - Migrate to E Certificate
  - Automation of qualifications registration
