Overview of the Seychelles Qualifications Authority

• The Seychelles Qualifications Authority Act 2021 became operational on 1st May 2022

- The object of the SQA:
 - ➤ to develop, implement and maintain a national qualifications framework; and
 - to provide for quality assurance of the education and training system nationally.





Review of the NQF

- The review of the NQF started in June 2023 in partnership with JET Education Services, through Dr. James Keevy and his team.
- We have just finished updating the Level Descriptors. With the help of ACQF-ll through Eduarda Castel Branco and James Mwewa, we have finalised the NQF Pathways.
- The final SNQF document has been sent to Dr Keevy for a final check before it is deemed ready.




The Qualifications map gives a clear idea of:

- the potential academic and vocational/TVET route that a qualification offers.
- educational and training doors open and accessible
- possibilities in terms of education and training
- the hierarchy of competencies, with each level of qualification becoming increasingly more complex as progress is made up the pathway of the map which is best seen in the level descriptors.

Proposed new map





NQF Pathways

THE SEYCHELLES NATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS FRAMEWORK (SNQF) ACCESS, MOBILITY AND PROGRESSION CHART



KEY:

- Purple arrows: access, mobility and progression within and from the general education sub-sector.
- Green arrows access, mobility and progression within and from the TVET sub-sector.
- Blue arrows: access, mobility and progression within and from the higher education sub-sector.
- Double-headed arrows (brown/black): forward and backward access, mobility and progression across sub-sectors



Level Descriptors of the NQF

The previous Domains of the Level Descriptors were

- 1. Degree of complexity of tasks
- 2. Reasoning and problem solving
- 3. Knowledge
- 4. Autonomy and responsibility

Now we will use only 3:

- 1. Knowledge
- 2. Skills
- 3. Autonomy and responsibility

Review of the NQF Regulations 2008

- Start of process: 2022 (consultation with stakeholders, incl. staff of SQA, leaders of public and private Providers, Ministry of Education)
- Some new inclusions: Registration of providers, School inspection, CATS.
- All existing components have been updated e.g. more focus on Learning outcomes, detailed Appeals process.
- *Current status*: has been handed over to the Attorney General's office



Development of SNCATS

The Seychelles National Credit Accumulation and Transfer System (SNCATS) project is being funded by ACQF–II.

ACQF-II Mission in Seychelles 11-16 March 2024:

Technical visit included:

- workshops
- Visits to institutions
- Meetings with the SQA team
- Development of an Annotated outline for the SNCATS – Policy and Guidelines

Follow up: Capacity development Webinars on RPL and Learning Outcomes (17-18 April)



Development of SNCATS cont.

The way forward:

With the help of ACQF-II:

- o Inventory of Micro-credentials in Seychelles (as of May)
- Micro-Credentials Training Workshop 23rd to 25th
 October 2024 –
- *to include presentation of results of inventory of micro-credentials,
- *sharing and discussion on the draft SNCATS Policy and Guidelines.
- The Policy and Guidelines is expected to be ready by mid-November 2024 for presentation to the Cabinet of Ministers



A Review of policies and documents

Main documents for development/review in 2024:

- •Review of RPL Policy
- •Review of RPL Guidelines and related documents
- ODevelopment of documents in preparation for registration of private post compulsory education and training providers.
