

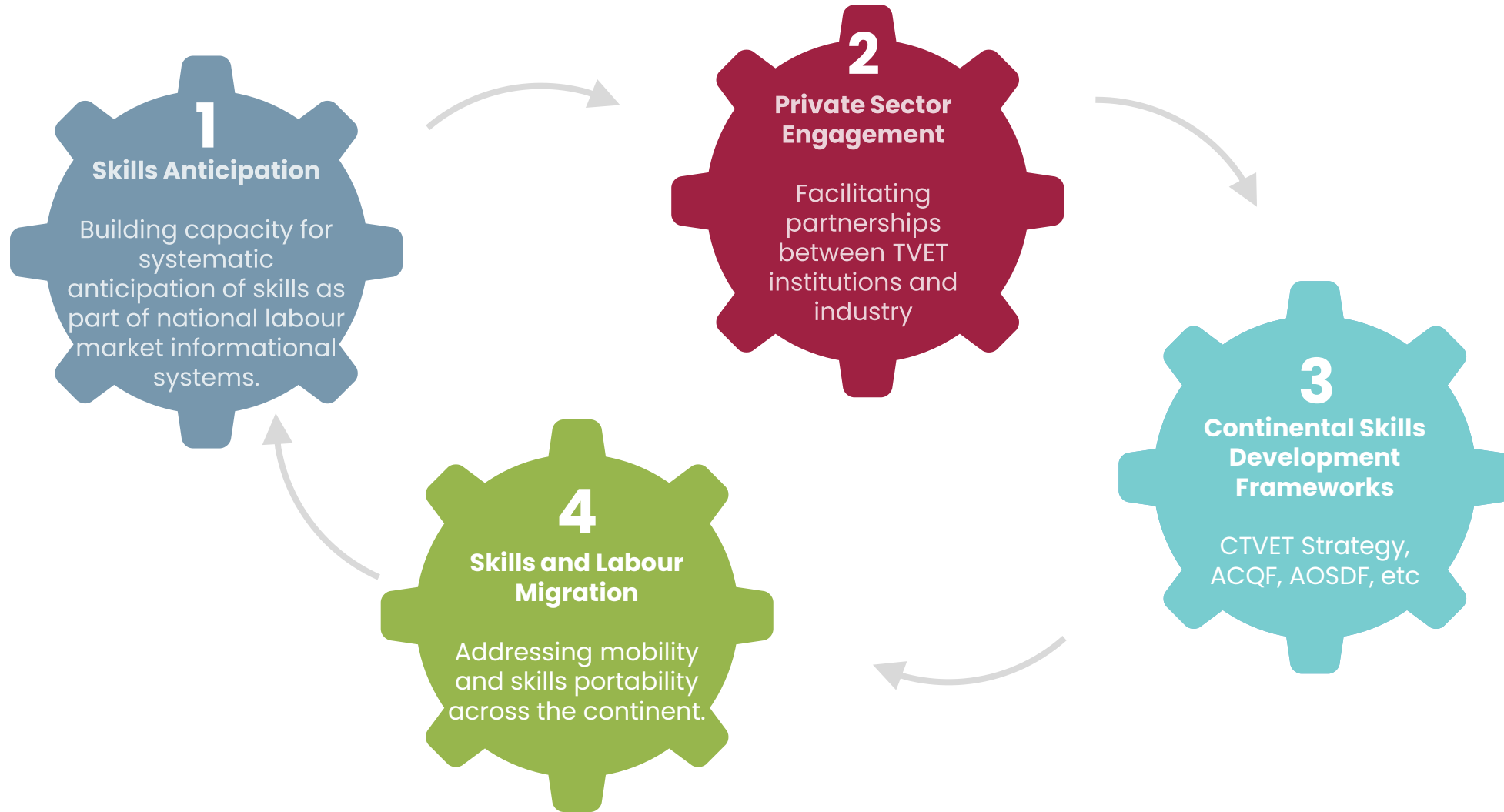


CONTINENTAL SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PLATFORM

ASPYEE PROGRAMMATIC FOCUS

INTEGRATION OF ASCB & SKILLS INITIATIVES WITHIN ASPYEE

Energize Africa will anchor AUDA-NEPAD's HCID skills flagship programs under the ASPYEE platform. These initiatives include the African Continental Qualifications Framework (ACQF), the African Occupational Standards Framework (AOSF), the Skills Initiative for Africa (SIFA), World Skills Africa, and other strategic efforts.

Centralized skills data

The integration of the ACSB & skills initiatives within ASPYEE ensures that insights derived from the database are widely accessible to stakeholders involved in skills planning and employment facilitation.

Evidence based policy

This move not only strengthens the platform's capacity to deliver workforce insights but also enhances ASPYEE's role as a vital hub for promoting evidence-based policies that address Africa's employment challenges.

ASPYEE as an M&E mechanism

To strengthen skills data collection and support workforce planning, AUDA-NEPAD will enhance ASPYEE as a central Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) mechanism.

Real-time data insights

ASPYEE will introduce a dedicated data reporting template that enables Member States to log and update their national skills data in real-time.

Targeted skills interventions

The ACSB will request data from Member States on skills needs in AfCFTA priority sectors, enabling targeted interventions to address skills gaps and emerging trends.

By consolidating these initiatives, the rebranded ASPYEE will provide a comprehensive platform that enables policymakers, educators, and the private sector to access essential skills data, develop workforce strategies, and facilitate employment opportunities.
