The Council on Higher Education (CHE) has been mandated by the Ministry of Education and Training (MOET) to implement LQF as part of its extended Mandate. Implementation of LQF involves:

- Registration of all local qualifications on the LQF;
- Verification of both local and foreign qualifications;
- Evaluation of foreign qualifications;
- Development of a national learner records database; and
- Development of relevant policies for effective implementation of the LQF.

Lesotho Qualifications Framework

- Has 10 levels and is an integrated framework for all qualifications in Lesotho;
- Allows comparison of qualifications;
 Facilitates mobility of learners and professionals;
- Provides for all qualifications in Lesotho including Certificates, Diplomas and Degrees (General Education, Higher Education and Technical and Vocational Education);
- Covers professional qualifications (professional development awards);
- Includes accredited short courses/part qualifications that are credit bearing; and
- Provides a basis for evaluation of foreign qualifications.


Objectives of LQF

The objectives of LQF are:

- To integrate national qualifications into a single framework (Basic, TVET, HE, Professional Training & Part qualifications (short courses);
- To improve articulation and learner progression;
- To uphold equity & enable Basotho to acquire credible qualifications irrespective of age & level of formal education - Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL);

- To improve articulation and learner mobility through links and pathways between academic & TVET qualifications;
- To foster quality and relevance through outcomes and standard-based education & training;
- To acknowledge and value diversity and worth of all qualifications;
- To facilitate curriculum innovation and qualifications renewal;
- To upgrade TVET qualifications to higher levels;
- To provide a basis for quality assurance of education in Lesotho;

NB: Qualifications are not placed on the LQF automatically. They have to go through a quality assurance process to determine their appropriateness for a given level.

Verification and Evaluation of Qualifications

Qualification holders, employers or organisations requesting verification services should provide the following information:

- a.) Formal letter requesting verification of a qualification;
- b.) Certified copies of certificates and transcripts to be verified;
- c.) Name of awarding institution and name of country where the institution is;
- d.) Full name of qualification holder;
- e.) Year of admission;
- f.) Mode of delivery of the programme;
- g.) Minimum entry requirements;
- h.) Duration of the programme;
- i.) Date of completion; and
- j.) A letter allowing CHE to handle an applicant's personal information relating to qualifications.



Possible Reasons for Negative Feedback

In the case of negative feedback from CHE, these are the likely causes;

- The qualification is not accredited locally or in the foreign country of origin;
- The awarding institution is not recognised by relevant local authorities in Lesotho or in the foreign country of origin;
- The award does not meet the minimum workload requirements as guided by the Lesotho Qualifications Framework (LQF);
- The holder of the qualification does not meet the minimum admission requirements as guided by other policies including the LQF;
- The qualification was obtained under a collaborative arrangement that is not recognised locally or in the country of origin.
